Lost in the Woods -

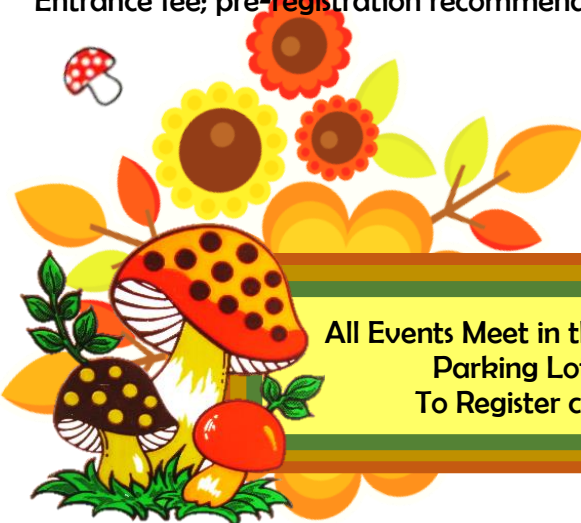
Sunday, July 21
